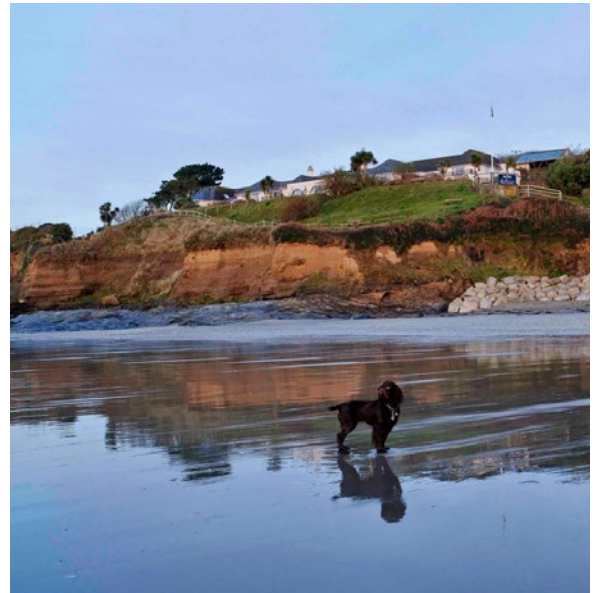
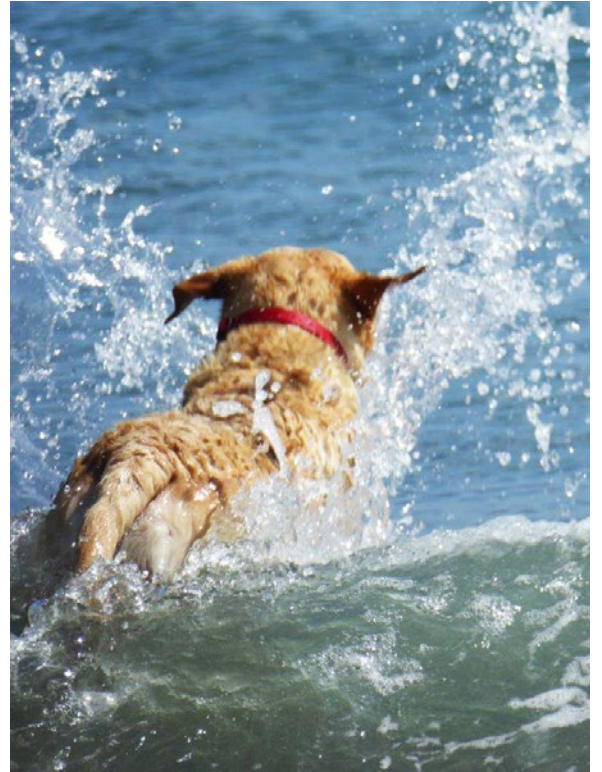
# Poolside...
